Responsibilities of a Senator

Senators are required to:

- Attend all weekly Senate meetings;
- Attend all Joint Senate meetings;
- Join and participate in at least one of the standing committees; and
- Hold one office hour per week.

Any Senator accumulating three or more unexcused absences from weekly Senate meetings in any semester or any one unexcused absence for a mandatory Joint Senate will be deemed by the Executive Board to have abandoned their seat.

Senators must participate in weekly committee meetings, and hold one office hour per week. Beginning with the third committee or office hour absence which is not excused, each subsequent absence will count as an absence from a Senate meeting for the purpose of maintaining the Senate seat.

To be excused from a committee or Senate meeting, a Senator must submit in writing to the Vice President for Administration and Public Relations a letter explaining the absence 24 hours in advance of the meeting. In extenuating circumstances, the President has the right to waive the 24-hour requirement.

The only exceptions to the above rules will be illness or death in the immediate family, or an academic commitment.
